



The project was awarded a Feed-in Tariff (FIT) contract in July 2011 as a result of the Bruce to Milton Transmission Line Expansion. The current design requires up to 46,000 polycrystalline solar photovoltaic panels with a rated power output of 290 W each to be mounted on horizontal beam single-axis trackers. The project will require installation of a new 34.5kV distribution line to be installed primarily below ground to a new 115kV substation adjacent to the existing Aylmer Transmission Station.
